

Greeter/Host Instructions

Many times you are the first impression a visitor has of First Lutheran and it's people like you who make everyone feel welcome here. A "greeter" is defined as "one who meets or extends welcome", while a "host" is defined as "one who takes particular care and concern that guests are well accommodated".

Please arrive at the church about 15 minutes before worship. Wear a nametag—these can be found in the usher stand at the back of the sanctuary (ask an usher to show you if you need help) and in the cabinet housing the fire extinguisher by the west door (parking lot entrance).

On the 1st and 3rd weekends of the month, everyone attending worship will wear nametags. If you are greeting at one of these services, please pay special attention to the visitors, introduce them to others you know who may be entering around the same time.
