#### **New Business**

- We Are The Church Highlights, Celebrations & upcoming events
  - o Organ and Hymn Festival Bell ringing was very emotional, amazing potluck
  - o Great new member orientation on 5.20.19 diverse group, stayed to connect with each other
  - Karin Blythe from LSS speaking about immigration helped us grow and broaden understanding
- Secretary's Report: Minutes from V.T. Meeting February 21, 2019
  - o Minutes March 21, 2019 Motion to approve Coty (M) Dick (S) Carried
- Sale of Douglas St. property update/new building update with Timeline
  - o Pastor Greg, Amy, and Dick attended a public hearing on 5.20.19 regarding conditional use permit for the use of the current FLC building. Concerns included increased traffic. 7-8 neighbors voiced concern largely emotion based. Mike Weber respectfully gave objective perspective regarding city ordinances. Commissioners voted and granted permission unanimously. Next it will go to the city council. The county continues to work through their process and checklist of contingencies. Sale is not final until the removal of the contingencies.
  - o Keys get turned over on July 1<sup>st</sup>. Site work continues, landscaping plans are underway. Outdoor worship space, meditation garden, gazebo, waterfall, benches, and columbarium.
    - June garage build.
    - July 15 move offices.
    - July 22 start officing at new site. Worship, funerals, etc. will continue at current site through August 3.
    - August 4 will be the "On our way rejoicing" service decommission the current church, and commission the new church.
    - August 5 everything will be at the new church.
    - Sept 8 fall festival & dedication
  - o Margaret how can the vision team support? Pr Greg: Through these events. Possibly host a table on Sunday's so the congregation knows who the VT members are. Amy through work with Jim LaDoux, we will get clearer roles with the strategic plan.

  - o Symbolic game to remember our 6 shared values.
- Next Steps with Jim LaDoux
  - o Specific, tangible ways for VT leaders to build up and execute tasks. We all know different people, together we can identify the right people to delegate to.
